## PECUNIA PROM-MH Compendium

The PECUNIA Patient-Reported Outcome Measure-Mental Health Compendium (PECUNIA PROM-MH Compendium) is a Microsoft Excel®-based electronic library of non-disease specific PROMs used in MH research. It provides meta-data information of existing, publicly available generic PROMs suitable for use in (mental) health research and their applicability in multi-sectoral, multi-national and multi-person (economic) evaluations. The PECUNIA PROM-MH Compendium was developed by the Department of Health Economics, Center for Public Health, Medical University of Vienna as part of the Horizon 2020 research project PECUNIA (ProgrammE in Costing, resource use measurement and outcome valuation for Use in multi-sectoral National and International health economic evaluations - GA No 779292).
